

Summer Office Hours

Reminder: The office is open from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm during the summer months. The office is closed from 12:00-12:30 for lunch.

FOBS

Remember...your FOB is assigned to you, do not let anyone else use your FOB to enter the building. If you need an additional FOB for a family member or medical professional, please contact the office to request an additional Key/FOB form.

IMPORTANT - REPORTING INCOME CHANGES

Please remember that it is imperative that you abide by program regulations. You must report any changes in your family income.

When you start a new job or change employment you MUST report the change to the office within 10 days. Do not assume that because the pay rate is the same that it is not necessary to report the change.

You must report ANY changes in....

- Employment including change of job or increase or decrease in hours worked.
- Child Support or Alimony
- Public Assistance
- Social Security or SSI
- Pension

- Workers Compensation or Disability
- · Veteran's Benefits
- Unemployment Benefits

Please <u>DO NOT</u> wait until you come in to the office to sign your recertification papers to report these income changes or to bring in your medical expenses.

Remember, failure to report income changes in a timely manner can result in you having to repay funds to the Amsterdam Housing Authority.



BED BUGS

Bed Bugs can be a big problem. Preventing them from entering your home can be easy if you take the right precautions. Bed bugs are usually unknowingly carried into homes by luggage, bedding, or furniture. To prevent an infestation, make sure you wash luggage and clothing immediately after returning from a trip. Also inspect used furniture before bringing it into your home. Never bring discarded bed

frames, mattresses, box springs, or upholstered furniture into your home. Make sure to clean your bedding and furniture regularly. Please call the AHA office immediately if you think you have a bed bug infestation & we will notify Charles the exterminator.



Mowing

If you have outdoor furniture, toys, bikes, etc., please make sure that everything is moved out of the way when maintenance is mowing!






