Cars

Cars, trucks & motorcycles are <u>not allowed</u> to drive inside the Garden Apartment complex at any time. This is very dangerous. <u>Do not park on Cedar St. at any time</u>, buses & emergency vehicles need to be able to get through.

Paying rent by check

If you pay your rent by check, please put the date that you are paying as the date on the check. When we take our deposit to the bank the bank will not accept a check with a future date on it.



Summer Reminders...

The warm weather will bring more people together outside. As you enjoy the company of family and friends, it is important to remember that you also need to be a good neighbor.

Apartments here are close together and loud noise outside apartments and in hallways may keep people awake and disturb their peace. Please be considerate; try to minimize loud noises such as loud music, loud televisions and loud conversations so that you are not disturbing your neighbors. If you are sitting outside, please be sure that you

and your guests are not blocking another tenant's entry to their apartment and be sure to pick up any litter from your gathering. Please remember that tenants are responsible for the behavior of their guests and you are responsible for any damage or disturbance caused by you.



Grilling

Hi Rise & Stratton residents are welcome to use the gas grills provided for each building. If you use the grill, please be considerate and clean it when you are finished.








Wait List opens May 21, 2019 at 10:00 am ET until

- Applications must be submitted on-line through Amsterdam Housing
 Authority's website until 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, July 7th. Applications will be accepted only during this period.
- Any individual who is income qualified is eligible to be placed on the Wait List. Other eligibility criteria is applicable when name is selected from Wait List.
- Applicants already on waiting lists for other housing programs must apply separately for the Housing Choice Voucher Program, and will not lose their place on other waiting lists when they apply.
- It is against HUD policy to charge an application fee. No payment or fee should be given to anyone in connection with the submission or processing of an application for any AHA Program.
- Applications will be placed on the Wait List according to date and time the application is received on-line and by preference.

The CHW Scholarship Fund

The Cannon Heyman & Weiss, LLP Scholarship Fund was created in 2013 to help students living in affordable rental housing developments realize the dream of furthering their educational training. Providing financial aid to qualified students is an extension of the CHW mission and reflective of our commitment to the affordable housing industry and community development. The Scholarship Fund is entirely underwritten by CHW and we are neither soliciting nor accepting outside financial support.

Scholarships will be awarded to successful applicants for full-time and part-time undergraduate study at approved colleges, junior colleges, technical schools, and other post-secondary institutions leading to a degree, diploma, or certificate. Study at the graduate level is not eligible for scholarship support. This year's awards are expected as follows: \$12,500, \$7,500, \$5,000. Receipt of other grants and scholarships may reduce the CHW Scholarship award if the total of all aid received is greater than the student's cost of attendance. Deadline for receipt of application: postmarked by June 1, 2019.
