IMPORTANT – Winter Parking

Any cars parked in the fire lanes will be towed without warning, at the car owner's expense. Maintenance needs to be able to access these areas in order to plow our parking lots.

Please be cooperative during snow removal. Please move your vehicles to cleared areas so that the maintenance staff can plow the parking lots more effectively.

Parking in all AHA parking lots is by permit only. Cars without AHA parking stickers will be towed at the owner's expense. Parking stickers will only be issued to cars registered to a household member listed on your lease.

Parking is <u>not allowed</u> in the AHA Employee parking lot on Wall St. at any time.

This is a reminder that winter is almost upon us & the snow will be falling soon...

The AHA Maintenance staff removes snow from roads, parking lots and major walkways after snowfalls.

Tenants in the Garden Apartments are responsible for clearing the sidewalks, ramps and steps leading from their apartments to the main walkways.

Salt is available to residents weekdays between 7:00am to 3:00pm. Hi Rise & Garden Apartment tenants can obtain salt at the rear entrance of the High Rise; salt for Stratton tenants is available in the Stratton lobby.

Tenants are asked to be cooperative during snow removal.

Please do not put any meat containers in the recycle bins, these containers should be placed in a bag and thrown down the garbage chute.



Police

Please report all criminal activity directly to the Amsterdam Police Department at 518-842-1100. If tenants are not willing to contact the police there is nothing that the office can do to resolve the issue. Once you have reported the matter to the police you can let the office know and we can request a copy of the police report if needed. The APD can come to the office to view our security cameras if necessary.



For your safety and to keep your belongings secure, we recommend that you lock your apartment door when you are not home.

Rent Changes

Whenever you have a rent change and come to the office to sign the rent change papers, the office gives you a copy of the form that tells you what your new rent will be and when it will be effective. Please keep this paper, tape it to your refrigerator or put it in your check book so you will remember when the change takes effect and will have the correct rent amount for your check or money order.



Fire Stoppers

Please **DO NOT** remove the fire stopper canisters from your stove hood. These are there to help prevent any stovetop fires from spreading through your apartment. Tenants will be charged for any missing fire stoppers.

Cold & Flu Season is here...

Keeping hands clean is one of the most important steps we can take to avoid getting sick and spreading germs to others. Many diseases and conditions are spread by not washing hands with soap and clean, running water.

Washing hands prevents illnesses and spread of infections to others

Handwashing with soap removes germs from hands. This helps prevent infections because:

- People frequently touch their eyes, nose, and mouth without even realizing it. Germs can get into the body through the eyes, nose and mouth and make us sick.
- Germs from unwashed hands can get into foods and drinks while people prepare or consume them.
 Germs can multiply in some types of foods or drinks, under certain conditions, and make people sick.
- Germs from unwashed hands can be transferred to other objects, like handrails, table tops, or toys, and then transferred to another person's hands.
- Removing germs through handwashing therefore helps prevent diarrhea and respiratory infections and may even help prevent skin and eye infections.
