Want to Save Money?

AHA can help Section 8 voucher holders establish and increase their savings: Through the Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) program, eligible tenants can save money when their rent goes up as a result of increased income. AHA will save the difference between an FSS participant's old rent amount and the new rent amount in a savings account. FSS participants save an average of \$2,000, though some graduate from the program with savingsof \$10,000 or more!

As part of the FSS program, the head and members of the household who are 18 and older are connected to financial empowerment opportunities, such as adult education classes, career counseling, vocational training, or help with accessing income supports (e.g.,SNAP/food stamps or free tax prep assistance), as needed. Tenants receive the model of the program of the p

Did You Know?

AHA has access to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Employment Income Verification (EIV) system. It is used to validate tenant reported income (wages, unemployment and social security benefits, etc.) at interim and annual reexamination interviews. EIV has been used to detect several cases of fraud, and unfortunately, families have been terminated for failing to meet their family obligation of reporting a change in income. HUD works with all housing authorities on enforcement.

Do you have a child going back to school or college?

AHA offers an income exclusion from employment for children under the age of 18. AHA also excludes earnings in excess of \$480 for each Full -Time student 18 years or older (excluding the head of household).

Helpful hints from the Inspector

We may not be Heloise, but here are a few helpful hints on in-expensive cleaning solutions that you might find useful.

Window Cleaners - If you would like your windows to sparkle, don't buy blue or green tinted solution from the grocery store. Instead, mix one-part vinegar to two-part water and pour into a spray bottle to apply. For an extra strength window solution, try mixing three tablespoons of ammonia to one-part vinegar and two cups of water. For lint free windows, use coffee filters or newspaper to clean instead of a cloth.

Stain removers – If you spill on carpets, furniture or clothing and a stain is left behind, don't panic. Make up a solution of one-part vinegar, one part mild dishwashing liquid and two parts water. Pour this onto the stain and blot until the stain is lifted. For a greasy stain, first pour baking soda or cornstarch directly on the stain and leave for an hour to absorb the grease. Vacuum the powder and use your homemade spot cleaner for any residue left behind.
